### 2 WAYS FOR SCHOOLS TO WIN

#### 'My Best School Trip' Award

This award recognises outstanding educational visits and is open for schools to enter, with a first prize of £2,000 for a future school trip.

Teachers outline what was involved, tell us how the trip achieved its objectives, why it was beneficial and how the learning was embedded back in the classroom.

Judging is carried out by a panel of experts and the winning trip is featured as a case study in School Travel Organiser.

#### **School Trip Champion Award**

There are so many people who play a pivotal role in organising school trips - so we created this award to highlight and reward them.

Plus, the winner will receive £2,000 to spend on a future trip for their school which is then featured in School Travel Organiser.
